WE'RE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR THE COMMODITY SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM

What is the Commodity Supplemental Food Program? (Mt. Healthy Alliance and the Freestore Foodbank would like to introduce you to the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP). This is a USDA program that allows income eligible seniors age 60 years and above an opportunity to receive, free of charge, a variety of nutritious food items on a monthly basis. This program will be provided to a limited number of income eligible seniors.

What is needed to apply? If you're interested in finding out if you're eligible and wish to complete an application please bring: (1) proof that you're a Hamilton County resident (a recent utility or phone bill, a rent receipt or other proof of residency are acceptable proofs of Hamilton County residency) and (2) proof that you are age 60 years and above (a state ID, drivers license, or birth certificate are acceptable proofs of age).

Where can I apply?

1. Apply at Mt. Healthy Alliance Food Pantry), (7717 Harrison Ave.), Cincinnati, Ohio 45231. Apply April 4th, 7th, 9th, 11th, and 14th from 9- 12 and April 5th and 12th 5-7 PM. At the Food Pantry.
2. Apply at Ridgewood Apts. 8127 Seward Ave. in the Community Room Tuesday April 5th 1-3 PM.
3. Apply at Affinity Apartments 7825 Affinity Place Thursday April 7th 1-3
